Application of Frederick Mc. Chesney No. 5021

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Deportation
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of May
A. D. 1928, at Price County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in 7th District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Christiansen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An indeterminate sentence of from
one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Dist. Att. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Frederick Mc. Chesney
I was convicted under the name of Frederick Mc. Chesney

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary, Assault
