and State of Utah, in 7th District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Chritcherson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 to 20 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state prison

Fourth-Honorable E. Keller prosecuted the case.
