Application of Michael J. O'Brien No. 4960

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th. day of January A. D. 1928, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in The Second Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Davoren Connell O'Brien I was convicted under the name of Michael J. O'Brien

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: NONE

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Attempted Robbery
Remarks: The petitioner has in excess to \$300.00 and desires to go to Phoenix, Arizona where personal and family friends will enable me to secure immediate employment
