Application of Donald Patenall No. 5148

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of Feb. A. D. 1929, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term of from one year to Twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Donald Patenall I was convicted under the name of Donald Patenall
