First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in One To Twenty Years under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of February A. D. 1929, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One To Twenty Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Donald Earl Patenall I was convicted under the name of Donald Patenall

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None
