I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination or Future Date and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of November A. D. 1925, at Ogden, County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence not to exceed five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Edmund Donaldson I was convicted under the name of Same

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None
