Application of Harry Williams

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the Nov 6 day of Nov. A. D. 1925, at Beaver Utah County of Beaver and State of Utah, in 1st District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Burton presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to Indeterminate sentence of One to Twenty years. and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State penitentiary

Fourth--Honorable Abe Murdock prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Harry Williams
I was convicted under the name of Same.

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand Larceny
Served Two years Reveal Florida in 1923.
