Application of Pedro Cisneros #4483.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault to Murder

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of November A. D. 1924, at Ogden, Utah County of Weber and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable Jos. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Pedro Cisneros I was convicted under the name of Pedro Cisneros

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except the one for which I am now serving.
