Application for Termination of Sentence:

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the County Jail of Emery County, Utah, under conviction and sentence on a charge of unlawfully and wilfully driving from their accustomed range, and wilfully and unlawfully neglecting to return to their accustomed range, 68 head of sheep-

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of June, A. D. 1926, at Castle Dale, Emery County, State of Utah, in the District Court of said Emery County, State of Utah, Honorable Dilworth Woolley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to five months in the County Jail of Emery County, Utah, and to pay a fine of \$150.00, and thereafter was imprisoned in the County Jail of Carbon County, the Jail of Emery County not being fit place and Sheriff of Emery County, arranging for my imprisonment in Jail of Carbon County.

Fourth-- Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case-
