Application of Andrew A. Jensen

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Penitentiary  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Persistent violator of prohibition law

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of February  
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Wight presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to Indefinite term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Penitentiary

Fourth--Honorable Assit. District Att. Samuel Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Andrew Alexander Jensen

I was convicted under the name of Andrew Jensen

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except larceny and violation  
of prohibition law.
