Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of October
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in THIRD DISTRICT COURT Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable JUDGE CHRIS MATHISON presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to INDETERMINATE
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.
