First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Liquor

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of May 1929

and State of Utah, in 4th Dist. Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. V. Watkins presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 3 mo to 2 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
for 6 mo and am on parole
