Application of Sam Marino No. 5132

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of February
A. D. 1929, at Price County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in The Seventh Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An Indeterminate Sentence

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable George Christensen prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Sam Marino

I was convicted under the name of Sam Marino

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows:
