Application of Sam Marino No. 5132

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Penitentiary
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10 day of February
A. D. 1929, at Price County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indefinite term of 6 months
to three years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Fred Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Sam Marino
I was convicted under the name of Sam Marino

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except what is
