under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary, 3rd degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of Jan  
A. D. 1929, at Price Utah County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in 7th District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Christensen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Serve 6 months to 3 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison  
at Salt Lake City Utah

Fourth-Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case.
