Application of Frank Mastal

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence (Conditional that I be returned to Colo. State Pen) and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of October, A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable A. A. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is I was convicted under the name of Frank Mastal

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Colorado State Prison.
