Application of William Mann No. 4992

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Stealing An Automobile

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of March A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd. District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 to 10 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Dist. Att. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Langston I was convicted under the name of William Mann

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: J W Johnson Mrs. William Langston Mrs. R H Durant

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None
