County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Burton presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to From one to Twenty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison

Fourth -- Honorable Grover A. Liddell prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Leonard Thornton  
I was convicted under the name of Leonard Thornton
