A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in the third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.
