I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in County Jail of Millard County
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Petit Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the twentieth day of March
A. D. 1929, at Fillmore County of Millard
and State of Utah, in the Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable LeRoy H. Cox presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to three months, (90) days in the County Jail at hard
labor, and execution of sentence was suspended for 30, upon giving bond for \$500.00
and thereafter was imprisoned in the

Fourth-Honorable Grover A. Giles prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Clifford Bennett
I was convicted under the name of Clifford Bennett

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Lenard Elder

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except none. I was cited before
the Juvenile judge once for taking melons with a boy who claimed he owned a
half interest in the crop.
