Application of Jack Kline No. 5095

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination,
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison,
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of November,
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake,
and State of Utah, in The Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Chris Mathieson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five years to Life, with a recommend
of one year by the Judge and Prosecuting Attorney,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Deputy District Atty A. R. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Chester M. Kline,

I was convicted under the name of Jack Kline.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows James M. Jones #5096 Released Dec. 21, 1929,
on Conditional Termination.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as the record shows.
