Application of Leland Hunt

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of April  
A. D. 26, at Richfield, Utah County of Sevier  
and State of Utah, in the Sixth Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable N. J. Bates presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable H. E. Beal prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Leland Hunt
