Application of Harry M. Dix

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for an unconditional pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Penitentiary  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of assault with intent to commit bodily injury

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the Twelfth day of April  
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable William S. Marks presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, the minimum  
being one day and the maximum five years.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Penitentiary

Fourth--Honorable Sam Clausen prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Harry Milton Dix  
I was convicted under the name of Harry M. Dix

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Harry Kennedy

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any <sup>other</sup> offense except larceny
