First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of July A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Minimum One Year to Maximum Twenty Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.
