Application of Adolph Johnson No. 5231

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 11 day of July A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McCauley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to twenty years in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
