and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Surgery

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 13 day of April
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Oscar Mc Conkie presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to one to twenty years - with
extreme lousiness. Recommend
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.
