Application of Charles E. Redding No. 7931

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Bank Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 3 day of December
A. D. 1927, at Provo County of Utah
and State of Utah, in (4) Fourth District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Parker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to (5) Five years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
at Salt Lake City, Utah.

Fourth-Honorable _____ prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Charles Earl Redding
I was convicted under the name of C. E. Redding.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except In 1922,
at Flagstaff, Arizona, for the
crime of Grand Larceny. Sentenced
to serve fifteen⁽¹⁰⁾ to eighteen⁽¹⁸⁾ months, and
served (13) thirteen months.
