Application of Charles E. Redding, No. 4931

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of December, A. D. 1927, at Provo, Utah County of Utah and State of Utah, in the Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George W. Parker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.
