First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in on Parole under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 3^d day of December A. D. 1927, at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in Fourth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Utah State Prison for a term of from 5 years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison Salt Lake City

Fourth-Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Charles E. Redding I was convicted under the name of Charles E. Redding

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows.
