To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary, 3rd degree.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 2nd day of August A. D. 1928, at the Court house County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wright presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to the Utah State prison for a period of from 6 months to 3 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the County Jail until I was transferred here.

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Wm. J. Walsh.

I was convicted under the name of E. J. Ryan.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except To the Honorable Board. Anything in the past is on record in the office and subject to your inspection. So it is the future in which I am to live the few remaining months or years allotted to me, I would prefer not to stir the muddy waters of the past, unless absolutely necessary.
