I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence,  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison,  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3<sup>rd</sup> degree Burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of August  
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake,  
and State of Utah, in 3<sup>rd</sup> District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Weight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to the State Prison for a  
period of from 6 months to three years,
