Application of Kenneth Goff No. 5077

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of October A. D. 1928, at Logan County of Cache and State of Utah, in the First Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable LeRoy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Kenneth Edward Goff I was convicted under the name of Kenneth Edward Goff

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above. I have never been in trouble nor in jail before.
