Application of Burt Dawson No. 6-214

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of June

and State of Utah, in 4th District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Larsen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 year to term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Dopey prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of Burt Dawson
