and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Bank Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 17. day of February
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Dist. Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Oscar McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Dis. Att. Rice prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is G. W. Funk
I was convicted under the name of G. W. Funk
