First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of February,
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable O.W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Mr. Rice prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Geo. W. Funk

I was convicted under the name of Same.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Jack Hardy and William James.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
