I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in County Jail, Utah County, Utah  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Battery

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of September  
A. D. 1926, at Provo City County of Utah  
and State of Utah, in the District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George D. Parker presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to serve a term of six months  
in the County Jail of Utah County, Utah  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the County Jail of Utah County,  
Utah, commencing on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of September  
1926

Fourth--Honorable M. B. Pape prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Alfred Davis

I was convicted under the name of Alfred Davis

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except the offense  
of Battery as above stated. I am now
