and State of Utah, in Sixth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Woolley presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth--Honorable Fred Keller prosecuted the case.
