Application of Harry Jackson No. 4875

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of June A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable I. B. Wight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
