Application of Frank Myers No. 4920

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Car theft

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the Fourth day of February  
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence  
of from one to ten years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable H. H. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Frank Myers  
I was convicted under the name of Frank Myers

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: James Fuson

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except None
