Application of Lewis Newbold No. 5055

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Reprived from State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of August  
A. D. 1928, at Ogden, Brigham County of Weber Box Elder  
and State of Utah, in 1st District Court Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-Honorable LeRoy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Louis Newbold  
I was convicted under the name of Lewis Newbold

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except That of record.

Note: I was reprieved by the Governor on June 26, 1929 and am now  
free by virtue of this reprieve.
